## Project Objectives

---

- **Reinforcing the ICT NCP network by promoting trans-national cooperation**
  - Identification and promotion of good NCP practices
  - Provision of dedicated training and twinning measures for NCPs
  - Provision of a quality checked Partner Search for the proposers
  - Raising the awareness for NCPs' services including the performance of practical initiatives which benefit cross-border audiences
  - Improvement of cooperation with other networks, organisations and initiatives

## Project Consortium

- Idealist Network of more than 60 Members = Beneficiaries and non-Beneficiaries
  - 33 Beneficiaries:
    - 31 MS/AS NCPs or working on behalf of the NCP &
    - 1 indep. Technical Officer (CPR)
    - 1 indep. QM partner (EFPC)
  - 30 non-Beneficiaries = Expert Group
    - 6 MS/AS (IE, FI, LT, MK, RS & Faeroe Is.)
    - 9 EEPC (AL, AM, AZ, BA, BY, GE, MD, UA & RU)
    - 5 MPC (MA, DZ, TN, EG & JO)
    - 7 Emerging Economies (AR, BR, CL, CN, IN, MX, ZA)
    - High-Income (Australia, Canada, South Korea, USA, New Zealand)



# Objectives of the PS System

---

- Provide a **ICT Call-Specific partner search facility**, with special focus on facilitating the participation of SME and less experienced organizations.
  - **7%** of the total number of proposal submitted to a given call with a QL.
  - at least 20 responses per partner search (actual average 45 responses).
- Contribute to increase the **quality** of those proposals finally submitted and hence the chances to pass the evaluation.
- Contribute to the **training** within the Ideal-ist network of those less experienced NCPs.
- Provide better and more accurate **statistics** on the use and effectiveness of the partner search mechanism and its impact in terms of proposals retained for funding.

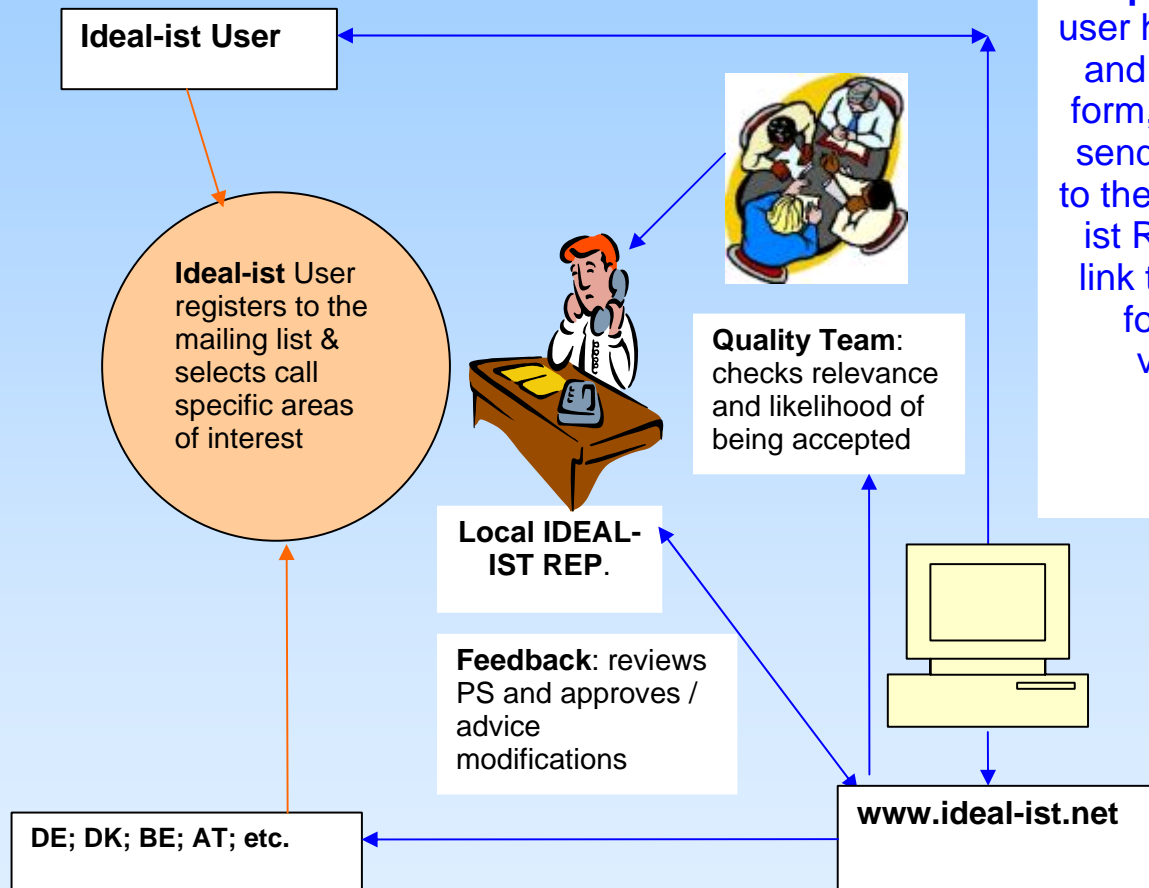




# How does the PS System work?

**Step 1** The user wishes to insert a new Partner  
Search on [www.ideal-ist.net](http://www.ideal-ist.net)

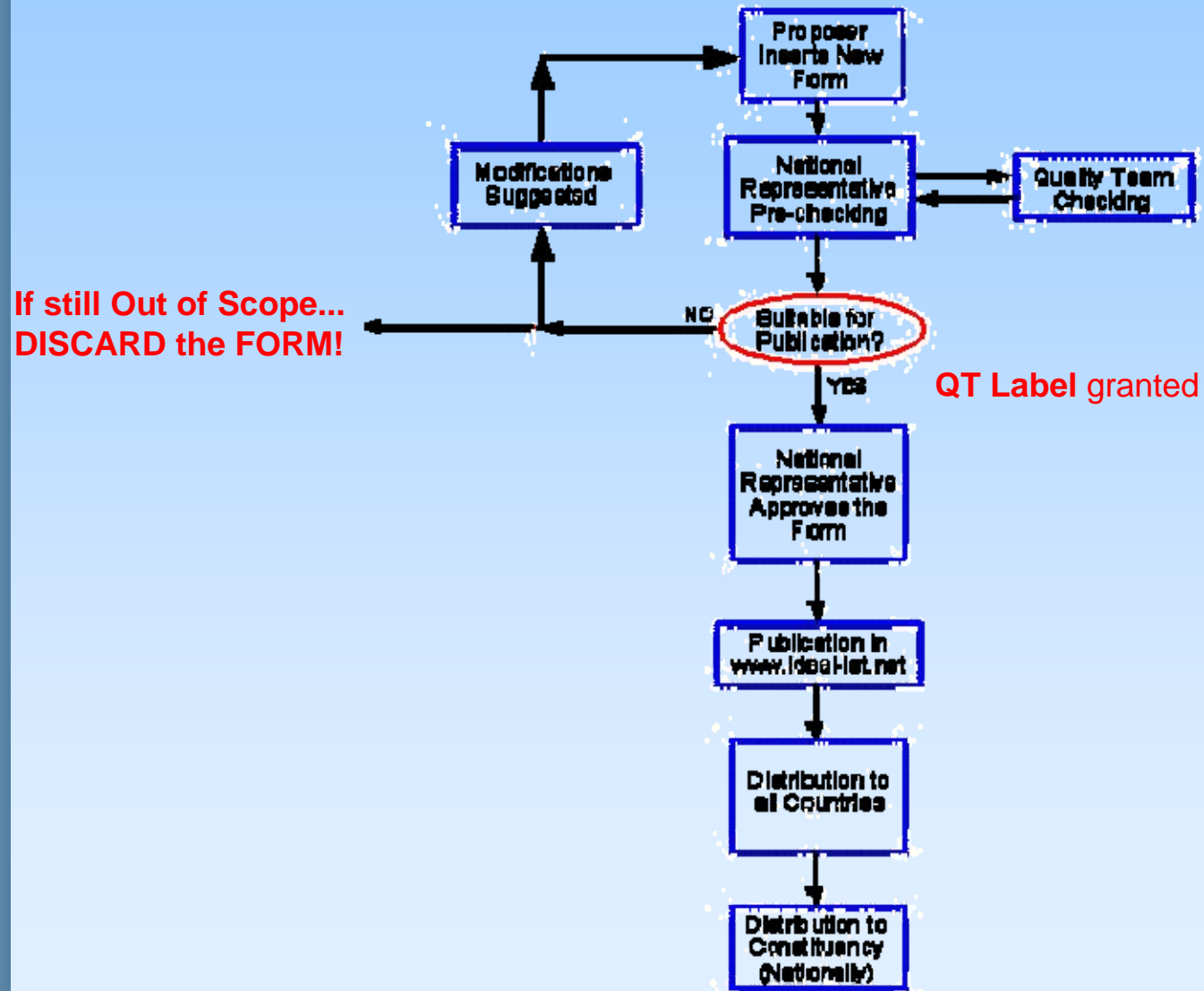
**Step 2** After the user has inserted and saved the form, the server sends an email to the local Ideal-ist Rep. with a link to the form for him to validate



**Step 3** Web page creation of the accepted proposal and submission to the Ideal-ist network
