- Conference center & teleconference facilities



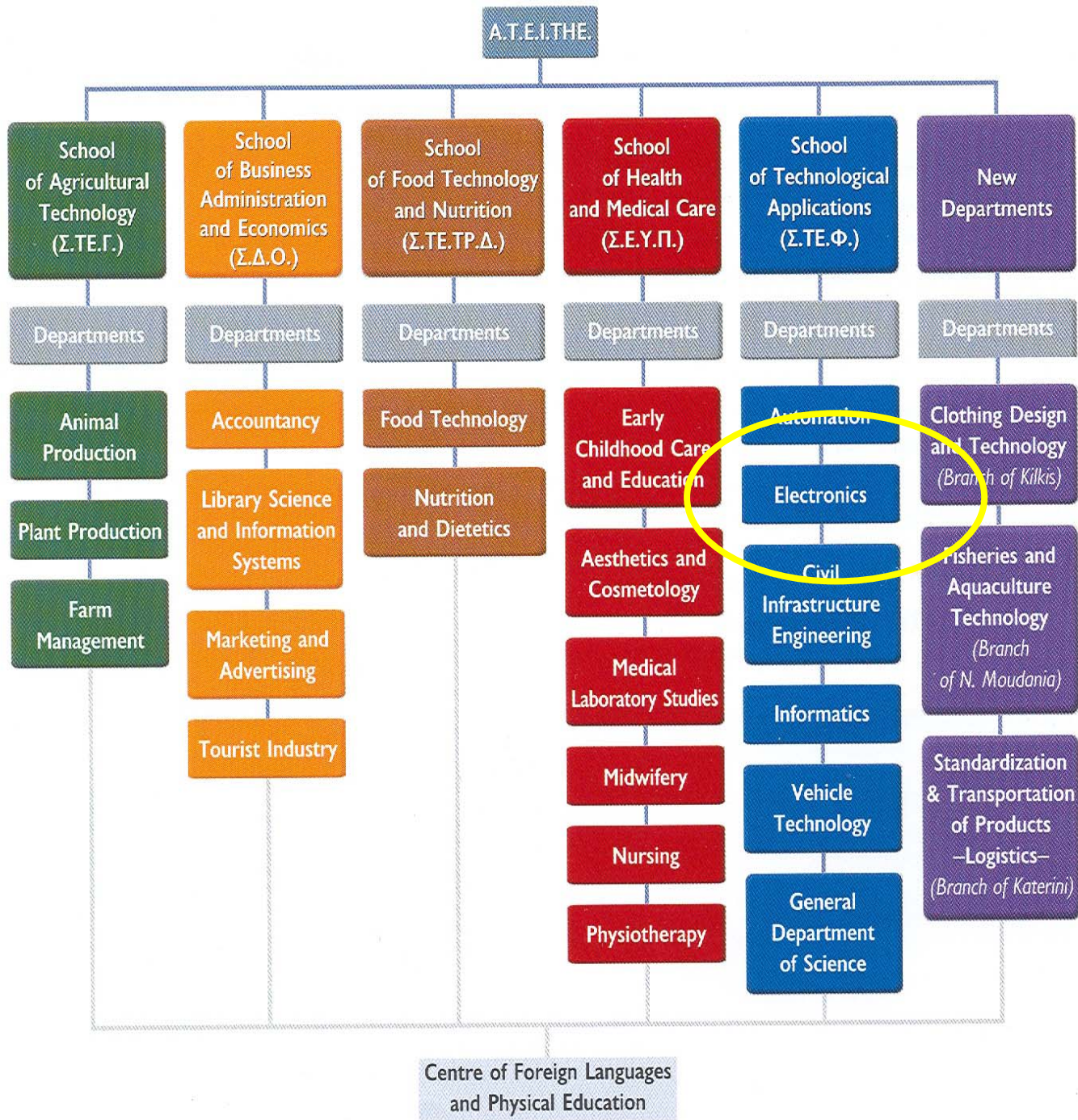

Introduction

This project is addressed to Lot 5 that consists of Armenia, Georgia and Azerbaijan, while the EU partners and associates are from Greece, Portugal, Italy, France, The Netherlands, Latvia and Bulgaria. The project targets to all groups (1, 2 & 3) and it provides opportunities of mobility to students (undergraduate & master), researchers (doctorate & post-doctorate) and academic staff. Priority is given on an impartial distribution of available positions to students with special needs and with socio-economical problems (without parents, divorced or ill parents, very low income, etc.), through a transparent selection process making use of a weight coefficient according to the category each candidate belongs to.

The main activities of the project for the academic year 2008/9 are:

- Three consortium meetings with the participation of representatives from all the partner institutions. The meetings will take place in Italy, in France and in the Netherlands
- Training programs for S. Caucasian Master students in Greece and in the partner EU countries leading to Master's Degrees
- Preparation and publication of a DVD on the project in English
